

## Sudbury Hill, Harrow, HA1

Set within the well-regarded Herga Court development, this expansive three bedroom apartment occupies the top floor and extends across approximately 1,237 square feet of thoughtfully arranged living space. Elevated above the surrounding rooftops and quietly positioned, the apartment enjoys an abundance of natural light throughout the day and offers a rare balance of space, privacy and comfort in one of Harrow's most established residential settings.

The main reception room is particularly generous, with clearly defined areas for lounging and dining, ideal for both everyday living and entertaining. 
# Area Map
